## Membership

We're currently at 213 members. Last year was 150 , so we're thrilled with progress this year.

## Teacher updates

It was confirmed that the Field day budget is currently $\$ 500$. The plan is to allocate $20 \%$ of funds raised from the Stall Day on $5 / 3$ to Field day. We will reserve roughly $\$ 250$ for an upcoming 3rd grade grant. 3rd grade may be doing an in house field trip. We have allocated funds for $3 r d$ and they can use them if it's in house or a traditional trip. 2 grants were paid tonight.

We would like to do teacher baskets at PICTO again this year. Mrs. Hopson will start requesting from teachers and target the 23 rd for responses. We had a discussion around some more creative options for baskets - ideas mentioned were an HSA VIP (free admission to events for one year), reserved parking \& seats for the 4th grade concerts.

## Fundraising

Erin Malloy will take on the school supply fundraiser. Welcome Erin!
Stall day will be held Fri May 3rd. Money raised will be split as follows: 50\% classes (legacy funds for 4th grade day), 20\% field day, $30 \%$ general fund (to build coffers). Volunteers will be needed (as determined by teachers)

Chirp workshop planning continues. Families can pre-order a bear with HES shirt for $\$ 25$. They can come stuff the bear at the Book fair family night and also visit a bracelet station to "name" their bear if they would like.

Nothing bundt cakes just closed. Similar numbers to last year, maybe slightly lower. Natasha will deliver to school on $2 / 13$. Several attendees offered to help deliver as it's the same night as the 2 nd grade concert.

Mr Cactus will be 2/12. Zaida will follow up with King Wing \& Roman Gourmet. Mrs. Hopson confirmed Bella for 3/5.

## Library / Book Fair

April is School Library Month. Mrs. Fox has found a website that manages library donations. We'll be confirming logistics, but it looks like families can order and it arrives at school with nameplate in place and ready to be shelved. We will target communications around this in April. It's a great option to recognize a child's birthday.

Book Fair will be Mar 15-22. Family night will be Mar 21. It was suggested that the reading schedule start a little after doors open. Allow families some time to get in and check out the bear area too.

## STEM Quest

STEM Quest was a huge success! Over 150 families joined us and it was nonstop for 2 hours. Using sponsors (local businesses and families) to offset costs was great. We raised over $\$ 1300$. The timing of last Friday in January worked out really well and will be the target for next year.

Discussed ideas for advertising more next year - there were not many sled entries this year. We discussed creating some short videos that could be shown during morning announcements. We could play leading up to winter break.

## Treasurer Report

After the last meeting we saw an opportunity to provide more transparency around the budget. Looking at a one page format to show net results for all fundraising events \& expenses. Goal is an easy to digest snapshot of spend. Financial summary reviewed and outlined below.

## Highlights \& Achievements

- Andrew has negotiated 2 FREE assemblies, eliminating $\$ 2500$ in expenses this year
- STEM Quest \& Pretzels outpaced expectations, resulting in ~ $\$ 2000$ profit
- Givebacks has eliminated \$1900 in expenses (credit card \& Konstella fees)

Budget Adjustments

- Teacher grants will be adjusted based on current spend. Line item reduced from $\$ 4000$ to $\$ 3000$. Current spend \$1300.
- Field trip contributions will be reduced from $\$ 2625$ to $\$ 1100$ to reflect the 2 grades planning trips.


## PICTO

We'll be asking classes / grades to get together on basket ideas. We can also get creative and have neighborhoods / buses create a basket. We will not be doing goody bags this year. All were in agreement they are not necessary.

Event volunteers - we are in good shape for set up. Craft a message for Mrs. Eckstein to send out specifically for volunteers.

## 4th Grade Day

Teachers would prefer that the committee chooses shirt colors. Emily confirmed she has the list of names for the shirt. Mrs. Moore will gather size info. Meghann will provide contact info for ScreenStyles.

## Yearbook

The cover sample looks great. Just a few gaps on pictures, but good shape overall. Will be sold for $\$ 35$.

## Beautification

We will be doing some more pickets in spring (after break). Families can purchase a picket and paint at home together. Can we put a small fence along the flagpole area? Just as a deterrent if classes go out for reading, etc.
